PUMPKIN BOWLING

This is a seasonal take on ten-pin bowling. In the run-up to Halloween, use ten small drink bottles for pins. You can give them the appearance of ghosts by painting in green white glue, paint and a drop of paint (thinner and yellow). Add faces to the sides with black marker pens. You'll also need small pumpkins with flat stems for bowling balls. If you can't find any, orange beach balls will do.

Add some glow-in-the-dark paint to each bottle so they don't topple over too early. Arrange them in a triangle and mark out the boundaries of your 'alley' with orange and brown cones, or string if you are outdoors, plus a starting line. Then, following the rules of ten-pin bowling, each player gets two goes at bowling to try to knock down as many ghost 'pins' as possible.

THE MUMMY CHASE

You'll need a garden to play this game for a quiet noon and understanding neighbour. Also a couple of tea rolls.

Divide the players into teams. Each team makes mummies. Give each team a couple of tea rolls and you can give Halloween-themed names. As the mummy game, your mummies will wrap their victims from head to toe, leaving just a small gap for the eyes and nose. Teams must use up all their tea rolls.

Once the mummification is complete, every team goes outside. Set up a starting and finishing line for a race between the mummies, who must complete it without their wrappings coming off. If the paper starts to unravel mid-race, the mummies must return to the starting line, where their team members can perform emergency repairs. The first mummy to cross the finishing line with bandages intact is declared the winner.
