

Adams Park - West London

Based in West London this exquisite historical building is surrounded by 100 acres of Parkland designed by Capability Brown, there are two lakes, lawns and meadows. Inside the building there is the Roman inspired Great Hall with Doric columns and statues of Roman nobles. There is the State Dining Room and the 136 foot Long Gallery, and the Green Drawing Room with an Renaissance style ceiling. The extraordinary Great Conservatory which was built in the 19th Century. Adams Park has featured in many film shoots, including Emma, Gosford Park, Killing Eve, The Diplomat and Bridgerton

Carroll County Courthouse, a historic building surrounded by 100 acres of Parkland designed by Capability Brown, featuring two lakes, lawns, and meadows. Inside, the building is managed by Carol Hayes Management.
