

Georgian Manor House - Kent

Georgian Manor House , is a very fine Grade II listed Georgian Manor House constructed in 1805. It is built of local stone under a slate roof with large sash windows giving delightful views in all directions over its own land. The main rooms follow elegant Georgian proportions with high ceilings and original features including decorative cornicing. The surrounding land comprises formal gardens, kitchen garden, estate parkland, a lake with a bridge and waterfall, 10 acres of arable farmland and woodland. The house comprises of 7 bedrooms and there is also a 2 bedroom farmhouse.
